The approval draft of the 'Living Clean' book is included in the Conference Agenda Report (CAR) that is available for purchase or download at [na.org/conference](http://na.org/conference). To download you will need the user name CP2012 and the password WSC2012.

As an interesting side note: 5000 copies of the 'Living Clean' approval draft have been distributed. That is 2/3 more copies than the approval draft of the 6th edition of the Basic Text in the same time period. Looks like the fellowship is excited about 'Living Clean'!

The revisions on the 'Social Media' service pamphlet that was out for review and input this past fall are complete. The pamphlet is now available online at [na.org](http://na.org).

Some of the results from the literature survey that was conducted last year have been released. 97% of fellowship members think there is a need for new book-length literature, 82% think we need a traditions workbook, and 81% want more information on service and recovery.
